TOBACCO BARN DISTILLERY

SUSTAINABILITY LEADERSHIP AWARD WINNER

Tobacco Barn Distillery is a single-batch distillery in Southern Maryland that uses its own farm-raised corn and locally sourced ingredients to produce bourbon, whiskey and rum.

Environmental Achievements:

- Offsets about 50% of its electrical usage through a PV solar array, a geothermal cooling system, and a waste heat transfer tank that captures and reuses heat from the distillation process.
- Reuses 100% of its cooling water, saving over 640,000 gallons annually.
- Sources more than 90% of its ingredients from within 15 miles of the distillery.
- Works with other farmers and local businesses to re-purpose barrels and bottles. Spent mash is donated to local farmers for cattle and chicken feed and "filter Bourbon" is used to make a local brand of soaps.
- Makes more than 90% of its deliveries in a Tesla.
