<u>Waste</u>

Solid Waste Reduction and Reuse

Within our graphic design department, concepts are created digitally and sent via email either internally for revisions or to clients for approval. This practice greatly reduces the amount of paper being printed in the office.

When we do have to print internally, for instance for weekly staff meetings, all documents are printed double sided. All invoices are sent via email rather than mailed. We also use filtered water instead of bottled water in the office and have a re-usable set of coffee mugs for use in the office instead of paper cups.



Recycling

BalanceLogic recycles the following items each month:

- Plastic Products
- Glass Products
- Paper Products including scrap paper, magazines and newspapers

Our standard practice for cardboard boxes that are received from shipping is to reuse between 80% and 85% of them in the office. Any that cannot be reused are recycled.

We also recycle our ink cartridges through Staples.

Energy Efficiency

BalanceLogic uses energy efficient CFLs. Compared to an incandescent 75W light bulb, we save 7,615 kWh and an electricity cost savings of over \$800 annually with energy efficient CFLs.

Many times, issues can be resolved by an IT staff member through remote access. This saves time and many miles that would otherwise be traveled to the clients' locations.
