Environmental Team

The Islamic Community Center of Potomac (ICCP) established a green team whose mission is to protect the environment through improving building facilities and practices and educating community members (www.iccpmd.org/green)

Environmentally Preferable Purchasing

All community meals (iftar) exclusively use compostable plates, cups, and utensils. Single-use plastic water bottles are banned from purchasing.

Environmental Restoration and Community Environmental Projects

The ICCP Green Team participates in trash cleanup activities with Montgomery County, Potomac Conservancy, Green Muslims, and other NGOs.

Waste

Solid Waste Reduction and Reuse

We prohibit the purchase of single-use plastic bottles for all events.

Recycling

We separate plastics, paper, compost, and trash with four different color-coded bins in our recycling center.

Composting

Food waste and compostable tableware are composted routinely. We collected 6,319 lbs. of compostable material since March 2022 and estimate our annual collection to be 20,000 lbs.
