We practice sustainable forestry practices and take down only trees that are diseased or affect our guests' safety.

We teach "Leave No Trace" principles to school groups and also teach them about the Chesapeake Bay Watershed.

Solid Waste Reduction and Reuse

We re-use items where we can. For example, we re-use participant gear by cleaning it vs. throwing it away. We use old cardboard for our build-a-boat, catapult, and fort team-building initiatives.

Recycling

We recycle an estimated 500 lbs. of mixed recyclables (paper, plastic bottles, and cans) annually.
