

## **Testing for Lead in Drinking Water – Public and Nonpublic Schools**

Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) is currently updating its training presentation regarding testing for lead in drinking water in schools under Maryland's law and regulations. Please note that some information in the presentation may be outdated - for instance, the definition of an elevated level of lead for school drinking water was lowered from 20 ppb to 5 ppb effective June 2021 per [HB 636](#).
